## Section 3. Hazards Identification

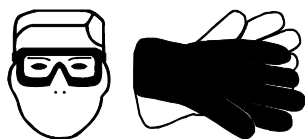

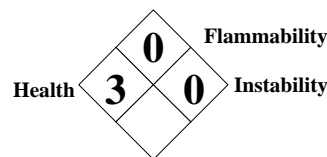
